Sin's Power Broken

When Jesus died on the cross, the power of the sinful nature in every believer's life was broken. This is an historical fact. However, it becomes a reality in the Christian's life only if he believes it. This means that the unloving you, the unforgiving you, the angry you, the lustful you, the anxious you...died at the cross. This also does not mean that if we now believe this we can begin obeying God by putting forth efforts to do so, simply knowing and believing that truth is not enough. The victory over temptation and sin will take place in our lives only as we believe the truth of the crucifixion of our sinful nature and also allow Christ to give us His victory. We must understand that we will be victorious over sin and temptation only as we allow Him to live out His life of victory in us: *For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and seeking to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted to the righteousness of God. For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes. Rom 10: 3,4 For to me, to live is Christ, and to die is gain. Phil. 1:21*
